The tax specialist will work under the direction of the MTC's uniformity counsel and support both MTC staff and our state members with advanced tax research and analysis, mainly focusing on complex business tax issues, including state, federal, and international tax issues involving large, complex, multi-national businesses, especially pass-throughs. The tax specialist may also participate in making presentations and in training staff and member states.

Those applying for this position should provide information on the following skills and experience:

- Tax research including for all state, federal, and international tax issues involving tax on business income;
- Audit or audit administration especially in the context of large, complex businesses;
- Drafting of tax legislation or regulations and/or providing analysis of tax law and regulations for lawmakers or administrators; and
- Training of tax administrators—including audit staff, legal staff, and/or others.

Minimum qualifications are:

- Advanced study or degree focusing on taxation including Masters, LL.M, or other specialization.
- At least 10 years' experience in tax administration generally which may include both state and federal experience and may also include audit, litigation, policy, or related roles.

This position is full-time.

The MTC is flexible with respect to work location, though employees residing in the Washington, D.C., metropolitan area are expected to be in the office at least two full days per week.
