



Multistate Tax Commission Audit Committee Meeting November 19, 2025

1. Productivity

The Joint Audit Program completed one (1) income tax audit and parts of seven (7) other income tax audits and parts of three (3) sales tax audits during the first quarter of fiscal year 2026. Currently, there are fourteen (14) income tax audits and nineteen (19) sales tax audits in progress.

During the first quarter, the income tax program proposed net assessments of \$14,643,938 for completed and partially completed income tax audits. Income tax program staff also proposed NOL and tax credit reductions of \$1,489,643. The sales tax program proposed net assessments of \$202,002 for partially completed sales tax audits.

2. Staffing

The Joint Audit Program experienced no staffing changes during the first quarter of fiscal year 2026. However, Ali Pazand was released from his position as Income Tax Auditor in early October. The Commission is currently in the process of recruiting a replacement for this role.

3. Audit Committee

The Audit Committee met once during the fiscal year on July 21, 2025 in Salt Lake City, Utah. During the meeting, the committee received an update on the progress of open audits and a SALT case update from MTC legal staff.

4. Training

The Commission is working to provide more content on its online training platform including a basics corporate income tax course.
