**To Members of the Uniformity Committee, Digital Products Work Group,
and Members of the Public:**

The next regularly scheduled MTC Digital Products work group call is **Thursday, December 4, at 11:00 AM Eastern**. The agenda is below and on the project webpage [HERE](#). Additional materials will be posted next week.

The work group's focus is on whether digital products can be defined broadly for general inclusion in the sales tax base, similar to the treatment of tangible personal property, and the issues that this approach might raise. During the November call the work group began a review of certain common exclusions and exemptions and how they might apply to digital products.

At this point, the work group is interested in any input from tax administrators, practitioners, and taxpayers as to whether common exclusions and exemptions can be adapted to digital products and whether this will present any unique issues that should be considered. The work group is also interested in how a broad exemption for business purchases might be best administered.
